4. Other Business

- **A. Water Conservation Planning**: Follow up with engineer that Ruby's is using, they have been helping them with a plan. Jones and DeMille were not aware of funding for feasibility study. Have not received any updates. Keep on Trello. Take off agenda until we get updates.
- **B. Marshal Evans Electrical bid for Shot Clock:** Waiting for them to install the clocks, should be sometime this month.
- C. Canyon 2 Canyon Follow Up: There were 549 riders registered and 525 ended up riding. Did anyone request refunds? Jade processed six refunds, the deadline for refunds was set at 6:30PM the night before the race. Those that did not show the day of the race and did not receive a refund had family members or friends ask to pick up their shirts. The school district only had one school bus driver, some confusion with Herb. Someone told him that morning he was not needed. The school district submitted reimbursement for \$258.85 mileage and driver wages for Kerry Barney of \$202.16. Next year make sure we hold to the final shut off time for registration – 9:30AM the morning of the race. The last shuttle goes into Bryce at 9:45AM. Erica, from the Forest Service reported everything went well at the bottom of Red Canyon. Did run out of shirts during registration and were able to use up some of the pink ones from last year. Forest Service wanted shirts, but we did not have enough for them. Kenny picked up shirts for the different stations. Need to order a few more shirts next year. Jail Ink needs at least two weeks' notice on shirts. There was an issue with communication between bottom pick up area and truck/trailer staging area. The only complaints were received were the non-transporting of e-bikes. There should not be an issue going forward, just need to coordinate with the right trailer and tail gates. Will need more help to load them. There was an a-frame sign stolen from the top of Red Canyon. Overall, the race was a success. After the bike path repairs there will still be some bumps from the bridge down to the bottom of Red Canyon that will not be fixed. Will have to notify riders next year of those areas. Trucks/Trailers – did fine, until the larger groups finished. Little bottle neck at the bottom. Will have a longer trailer to use next year. Velofix was busy fixing bikes. Had a few flat tires on the trail May need to put a tent at the bottom for shade if needed? If the 6th grade keeps that he helped with. the bake sale going each year, maybe move some of the bake sale to the end of the race. They do have treats at the station at the bottom. Deanna will work on the new special use permit with BCNP. They are good for 5 years, the current one expires the end of this year. Do we want to increase the fees next year? Do we want to push the deadline for refunds earlier than 6:30PM the night before? Tim,

Gary, and David used personal trucks, so they submitted mileage reimbursements.

D. Approval of using Garfield County Inmates to clean up Main Street: Not ready to schedule, will wait until October to plan them.

Piano Guys and Utah Symphony just a few big events that will be happening. Ice Rink – getting ready to pour concrete. Missing last order of foam, picked it up yesterday. Contractor almost finished.

CIB Asset List- will work with Jones and DeMille to create the list.

Divvy Card – Mayor has reached out to Preston and has not heard back.

Brycecanyoncityut.gov website proposal- Mayor presented the new website. There is a link on Mayors Trello card to the site. The mobile site will look a little different. Jade recommends using other pictures, maybe some arial photos of Bryce Canyon City. Under Local Attractions -Kodachrome picture needs to be updated, it's a St George picture. Minutes and Agenda links are pulling up forms, not appropriate files. Add Wellness Center to the main header. Remove the newsletter links. Instead of upcoming events add the google calendar the city has. Add ice rink to website with the nonprofit information. Need a banner at the top that links to visitybrycecanyoncity.com. It is at the bottom of the website. Mayor will let Online Web Marketing know of the changes discussed today.
