Ice Rink: Jade working on punch cards for all Garfield County Students. Working on the best solution for charging guests. Rod is asking on behalf of Ruby's Inn, that they sponsor all students in Garfield County to skate for free. Tab would be kept, and Ruby's will cover the cost. Friday nights and during winter festival days would be blacked out dates. Parents can skate for a local discount \$3.50 per skater. There are local discounts for the other counties as well. Regular guests will be charged \$7.00 per person. Discussion on restricted parking, some spectators want to watch from vehicles. They will clear out the north end of the rink so they can park there to watch. Large pile of gravel was moved to clear out parking area. They did have a scare when one of the pumps quit. Andy was able to fix the issue, it was just a simple lose connection. Running good so far. The pumps will back each other up. First power bill was around \$3,200.00. Did not show the demand charges. One pump will run 24/7. Lights were only \$100/ they put on timers now so that may be cheaper going forward. Working on set hours to open the ice rink. Tera was here from Utah Outdoor Recreation and was impressed with how the rink turned out. Very impressed with the railing. The one in Millcreek was a little bigger and they were also behind a year and a half on completion. Ice is good right now! And they do not have any leaks!

**Deanna Moore:** Received the full \$3,000.00 from Garfield Travel Council for the Canyon 2 Canyon bike ride. Need to get Taryn to attend these meetings with Deanna.
