B. Tim Leech – Noah Basketball Purchase for Wellness Center: Moved to first discussion on the agenda.

Tim Leech present to discuss the system. It is a 3D sensor basketball system. Measures the arc of a shot, as well as left and right measurement of the shot. Will give feedback to the player right away. Will track on a phone app. It is a full court system. It will cost around \$4800 upfront. The half court option is cheaper. After the upfront cost, it will be \$1200/year for the annual subscription fee. The annual fee includes all upgrades and will give access to player apps. Can track multiple players at once. It has Bluetooth so it can be linked up to ear pods. Will track all shots when players are logged in. It will grade the player shot as well.
