A. Approve Road Seal Bid: Still need the line painting bid. Crack seal estimates are \$36,700 for east side new pavement. West side – near Lake Side Drive will cost \$20,350.00 that will need crack seal as well as some minor repairs.

C. Scholarships: We received a total of eight applications. The city offers eight each year, so all will be awarded. Those received from Bryce Valley - Bradi Gates, Sophia (Gracie) Wiseman, Makyndie Clark. Panguitch – Kenli Hatch, Triston Houston, Janessa Heaton, Madelyn Frandsen and Tylee Barney. We did not receive any from Escalante.

D. Bryce Valley Baseball Donation – Score Board: Coaches Mike Ahlstrom and Tyson Brinkerhoff present. They are very appreciative of the city help towards the baseball program. They are working on a new score board – original one has been there for about 20 years, its small and hard to read. The rules have also changed so pitch count is needed on the score boards. Modeled the design based on surrounding score boards and recommendations. Working on the color of the score board. The sun hits the current one and working on logistics there. The new lights will be LED so the sun should not have as much impact. May have to move conduit if the score board must be moved. This will require additional costs.

The total bid is \$50,000 with installation. May be able to save some on installation with volunteer labor. They have received donations or commitments from State Bank of Sothern Utah, Bryce Canyon Half Marathon, and will be asking other communities and businesses. They will be meeting with the School Board and County.

Concerns that Tropic Council may not be supportive of the baseball field. Mike Ahlstrom reports that Tropic Town is very appreciative of the help for the baseball field that Bryce City gives. There are some concerns with costs, but the baseball field does generate tax revenue for Tropic.

Could the old score board be moved to little league field? One issue with it is that they cannot find a new remote as it is very outdated. Might need some electrical work but can look into it. Also looking into softball on that field as well.

Right now, they are asking for donation of \$5,000.00. If more funding is required, they will return to request more.

Motion to approve a donation of \$5,000.00 now made by Bryce, 2nd by Kam, Cherrie yes.

E. Canyon 2 Canyon Changes: In a holding pattern. The Hoodoo 500 bike race will happen that same day which will affect Red Canyon. They are not allowing any cars at the bottom nor the visitor center. Tyla, Chief Ranger with BCNP is concerned with parking at Inspiration Point if riders are not shuttled. The Fly-In will happen the same day.

F. Gym Floor Reseal Bid: They did give us a discount last year for an area they had to fix. The bid received this year is for \$6,900.00. They have two available times in the summer or wait until October. The bleacher area may cut the cost. The available dates are May 29-31st or June 4-7th. Best to plan for the May dates.
