A. Purchase Speed Bumps- Purchase more for employee housing area, need some by Dean and Blaine's houses. What about speed humps? Do they tear off bumpers? Ron looking into some for Ruby's. The speed bumps at Escalante View have moved so cars cannot go around them anymore, however people are moving them. Will need at least two sets of either the bumps or humps. The speed bumps we have purchased were \$1,300 plus \$365 in shipping. Mayor can work on a quote for the purchase of speed humps. Ruby's may need to discipline employees if they are causing the issues. Would be beneficial to have more law enforcement in the area. The speed bumps must be fixed all the time, and it would be beneficial to look at more permanent solutions. Motion made not to exceed \$5000.00 to purchase speed humps or bumps, made by Gary, 2nd by Kam, Bryce yes, Cherrie yes, Mike yes.

B. Ron Harris – Response Truck Maintenance- The red Command Vehicle needs a transmission. The cost will be \$5500.00 just for the transmission. There will be more cost for shipping and labor. Vehicle cost was shared by Bryce, Tropic and Garfield County. Ron covers most of the gas personally. It has 86,000 miles on it. Transmission arrived yesterday. Tropic budget could cover labor if Bryce City would cover the cost of the transmission. Motion made by Gary not to exceed \$6,500.00 for the transmission, 2nd by Bryce, Kam yes, Cherrie yes, Mike yes.

Ron reported that ambulance/instructors appreciate allowing the county to use the Public Safety facility for EMT class this year. We had 8 students from our area that finished, still need to take the national testing before they can be certified. Panguitch had 4 take the class and Escalante had 1. In need of Bryce Canyon City EMTs.
