4. Other Business:

A. DeAnn Brown – Garfield Memorial Health Care Foundation: DeAnn is the Garfield Memorial Hospital and is present to discuss the hospital and not the foundation. Garfield Memorial is a Critical Access Hospital. They have over 150 employees, 10% from Bryce Valley area. Received many awards over the past few years. Ron Harris and Kerry Alvey represent this area on the Hospital Board. DeAnn welcomes any recommendations from the city. Dr. Birch has retired. Kelsey Allen, daughter of Kelly Baugh will be signing on to replace Dr. Birch.

Cherrie asked about Mobile clinic – it was hard to staff, and it was not feasible. They did have it in Glendale last year, just did not have Dr Staff last year to have it anywhere else. They can revisit the plan to extend the areas again.

Operating Room is being remodeled and expanded. Will be bringing back some general surgeries.

B. Bryce Valley Elementary 6th Grade Washington D.C Fundraiser: Four students gave presentation to discuss the annual Washington D.C trip. Sixty-three students from Garfield County School District will be going, 14 will be from Bryce Valley. There will also be teachers, administrators, and parents. All adults pay for their own trip. The cost is \$850/student. They are holding various fundraising activities. Students discussed what they are excited to see.

C. Tim Gates & The Nashville Tribute Band: Tim & Amber present to discuss a donation for Nashville Stars, not Nashville Tribute Band. Want to make it larger this year. Have asked businesses in Tropic and Panguitch for donations. Want to hold a concert on the Ruby's Rim. Bring in another larger artist. This is a popular activity each year and brings Garfield County together. Allow the young players with Bryce Canyon Wranglers to play as well. Asking for \$5,000.00 donation for the event. Want to continue this annually. Planned for August 2nd, 2025. Funds must be committed by December 31st,

2024. The larger band needs to be booked by January. They must work through agents to book the band. Bryce Canyon Wranglers will be the opening act. Will still have the inside show on August 1st. Jean – asked about other sponsors- Tim reported that Tropic, BCNP have committed funds, and they are going to Panguitch next week. Private businesses have donated as well. Motion to commit \$5000.00 towards the event, contingent on gathering all funds required by December 31st, 2024, made by Mike, 2nd by Kam, Bryce yes, Cherrie yes.
